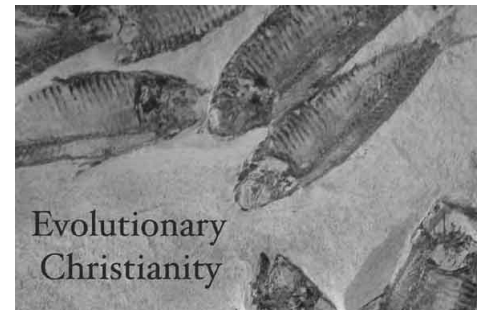


The Gospel According to Evolution: Great News Personally and Globally
