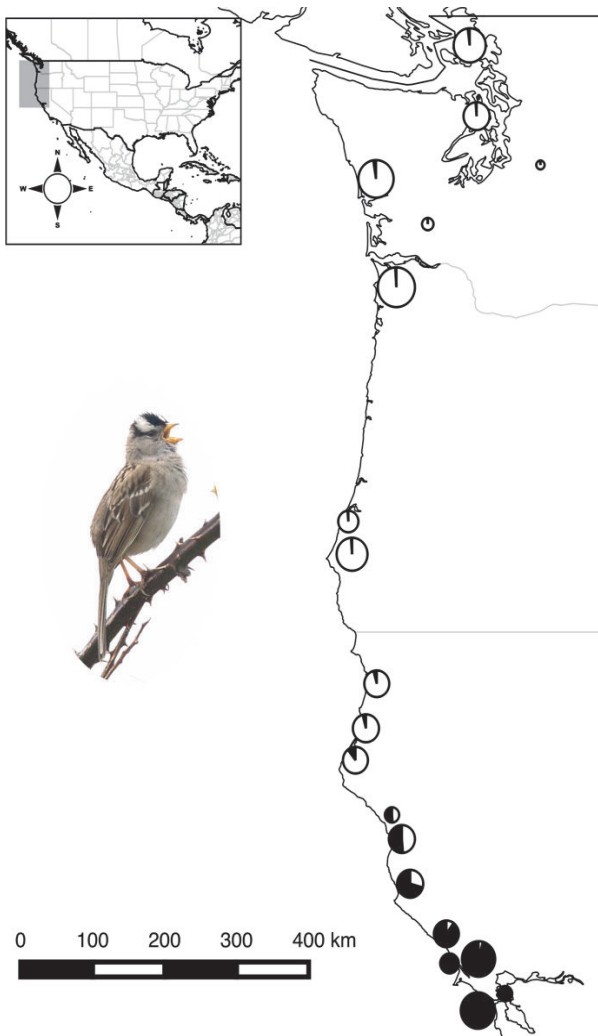
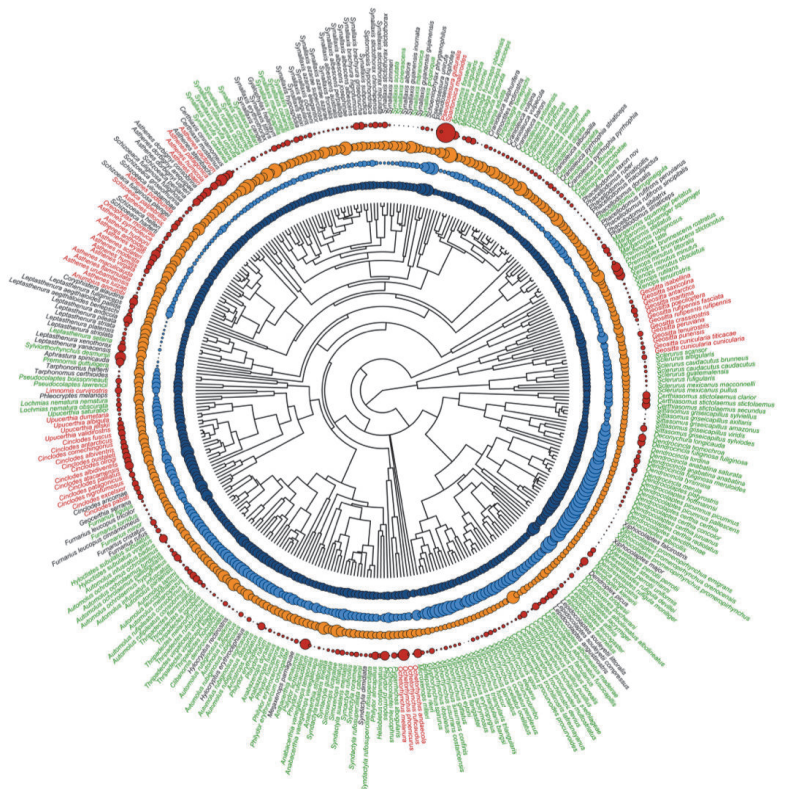

"Ecological drivers of song diversification in birds"

Elizabeth Derryberry will be presenting her research on how ecology drives divergence in songs, and, in turn, the interplay between diversification of these mating songs and speciation. She will address these questions first in a tropical radiation of 300+ species of ovenbirds and woodcreepers (Aves: Furnariidae) in South America. She will then outline a current project on the ecological genomics of behavioral isolation using a contact zone between two subspecies of white-crowned sparrows (*Zonotrichia leucophrys*).
